

## COOKIES POLICY OF COCONAUT.COM WEBSITE

1. This **Cookies Policy** sets forth the rules for collecting user data by means of cookies files during the Users' use of www.coconaut.com website.
2. The website referred to in Clause 1 is operated by:  
**Quest Food** spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with its registered office in Kostrzyn, ul. Okrężna 18, 62-025, registered by the District Court in Poznań – Nowe Miasto and Wilda in Poznań, 9th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under no. KRS 0000612155. The company's share capital amounts to PLN 1,500,000.00 and has been paid up in full. Tax identification number (NIP): 7773260066 and business statistical number (Regon) 363971260, hereinafter Quest Food.
3. **Cookies** shall be understood to mean the IT data stored in the users' terminal devices intended for accessing websites. In particular, cookies shall mean text files containing the name of the website from which they originate, duration of their storage on the terminal device and their unique number.
4. The Website shall not collect automatically any information, except for the information contained in **cookies**.
5. **Cookies** are intended for accessing the Website's pages. The operator uses these files to:
  - a. Adjust the webpage's content to the user's personal preferences; cookies primarily recognise the user's device in order to display the webpage consistently with the user's preferences
  - b. To create anonymous statistics with exclusion of the user identification option.
6. **Cookies** used by the partners of the Website's operator, including specifically the Website's users, are governed by their own privacy policies.
7. To ensure security of the data entrusted to us by the Users, **Quest Food** represents that it has developed internal procedures and recommendations that are designed to prevent disclosure of data to unauthorised third parties. **Quest Food** monitors enforcement of these procedures and recommendations and continuously checks their compliance with the applicable legal framework, including specifically the Personal Data Protection Act, the Act on Provision of Services by Electronic Means, including also implementing regulations to these acts and the European Union legal framework.
8. As a standard, the software used for web browsing permits, on a default basis, placement of **cookies** on the user's terminal device. These settings may be changed by the user in such manner as to block automatic processing of cookies in the browser's settings or to inform the user about their transfer to the user's devices each time.
9. The Website's users may change the settings governing cookies files at any time. The detailed information about the possibilities and ways of processing cookies files is available in the settings of the browser's software. Example editing options in popular browsers:
